Dear Artist,

*You are cordially invited to participate in the **Oil Heritage Children's & Young Adult Art Show** sponsored by the Oil City Arts Council. This year's exhibit will be held from Monday, July 20th through Sunday, July 26th in conjunction with the annual Oil Heritage Festival which runs from Thursday, July 23rd through Sunday, July 26th. The site of the show will be the National Transit Building Annex/ Third Floor, 206 Seneca St. in Oil City, Pennsylvania.*

*An **Artist Reception** for the Oil Heritage Art Show will be held on Monday, July 20th from 7-9pm. This event as well as the exhibition will be open and free to the public.*

ENTRY INFORMATION:

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY...TWO FEE OPTIONS!!!

1. **Early Bird Registration:** \$10.00 for one or two entries; \$15.00 for a maximum of three entries. **These entries (paperwork only-with completed artwork labels, application and fees must be postmarked or hand-delivered to Art Show Chairperson on or before June 30, 2009.** PLEASE NOTE: A fourth entry will be allowed without additional fees, by submitting 1 piece of the 4 in the Oil 150 Category. (See New Categories – page 2)
2. **Regular Registration:** \$15.00 for one or two entries; \$20.00 for a maximum of three entries. **These entries (paperwork only with completed application and fees) will be postmarked after June 30, 2009 -or- can be hand delivered prior to show to Art Show Chairperson.** . PLEASE NOTE: A fourth entry will be allowed without additional fees, by submitting 1 piece of the 4 in the Oil 150 Category. (See New Categories – page 2) **Artwork, all Forms/Fees can also be submitted during specified drop off dates, before the Actual Show.** (See Delivery & Pickup of Artwork – page 3).

CATEGORIES: PLEASE REVIEW *NEW CATEGORY ADDED**

1. PAINTING: To include acrylic, watercolor, oils, etc., any painting using a single (one) medium.
2. DRAWING & GRAPHICS/MIXED MEDIA: To include pastels, pencil, charcoal, block printing, screen printing as well as mixed media works. (Mixed media is considered 2 or more mediums used per work.)
3. THREE-DIMENSIONS ARTS - Any medium which projects from its base, ground or support more than two inches. To include pottery, sculpture, woodcarving, fiber arts, stained glass, etc.
4. PHOTOGRAPHY – Any two-dimensional work wherein the entire work is created by photographic process. To include black and white and color.
5. COMPUTER GENERATED OR ENHANCED WORK – Any two-dimensional work wherein the work is created and/or enhanced by computer process(es).
6. *****NEW CATEGORY*** OIL 150 *****
To Celebrate our region's Oil 150 year through art expression at this show, all artists are invited to submit a fourth entry for this separate category. All entries will be judged on the work based on the following title, "IT'S AN OIL LIFE". There are no medium specifications or size restrictions. (Only that the work remains family friendly.)

AWARDS:

1. The exhibit will be professionally judged with ***Cash prizes and Ribbons awarded for First, Second and Third*** places in each category. First prize: \$20.00, Second 15.00, Third 10.00. **(INCLUDING THE OIL 150 CATEGORY)**
2. One ***Cash prize and Ribbon*** will be awarded for "Best of Show" (judge's choice). Cash Prize \$20.00 (Grades 9 – 12 combined)
3. ***Honorable Mention Ribbon(s)*** awarded to work(s) as per judge's selection.
4. One ***People's Choice Award*** Ribbon is awarded, as per selected popular vote (no cash prize.) (Grades 9-12)

GENERAL RULES:

1. Artwork must be original (no kits). The show chairperson reserves the right to refuse any entry that is inappropriate for family viewing.
2. Previous prize-winning entries in the Oil Heritage Art Show cannot be entered.
3. Please label your work on the back of each piece with ID cards enclosed (or base of 3D pieces). Two-dimensional artwork **must be framed and wired and ready for installation upon delivery.** Improperly prepared art (not completed/framed and wired) will not be accepted.
4. Artists must sign the enclosed release form when the artwork is delivered to the show.
5. Artwork will not be accepted after 8pm on Friday, July 17th
6. The submission of artwork to this show constitutes the artist's permission for general publicity.
7. Artwork submitted cannot be sold in the Young Adult Division of the Oil Heritage Art Show. If a Young Adult wishes to sell their work, they must exhibit in the Oil Heritage Art Show.

DELIVERY & PICK-UP OF ARTWORK:

1. Artwork must be delivered to the Oil Valley Center for the Arts in the National Transit Building Annex in Oil City on Thursday, July 16th between 3-8pm or on Friday, July 17th between 3-8pm. **Art will not be accepted after 8pm on Friday, July 17, 2009, and no refunds will be made.**
2. Artwork must be removed after the show closes on Sunday, July 26th. Pick-up times are 4-6pm Sunday July 26th or Monday, July 27th between 4 – 8pm. If an artist wishes to send a delegate to pick up their work, they must notify us in advance or send a signed permission note with the delegate at time of artwork drop-off. All items must be signed out for release.
3. The Oil City Arts Council, OVCA or chairpersons will not be responsible for any art remaining from this show after 8pm of Monday, July 27th.

As an artist, you and/or your parent or guardian together, are invited to help participate in the art show by volunteering as a show guide or a “show-host”. If you and/or your parent or guardian(s) are willing to contribute a couple hours of time, we do welcome your help. Please check “yes” in the box on your application form. Thank you!
